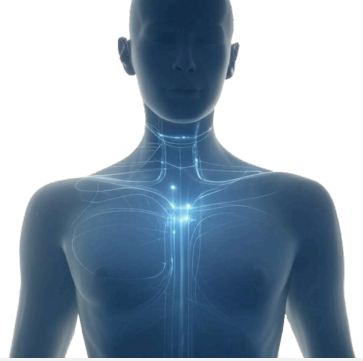


# AIT and Psychogenic Myoclonus

## TREATMENT & RESULTS

### Initial Treatment & Results

Patient received three treatments and, since leaving, has reported that the ticking behavior is almost nonexistent.
